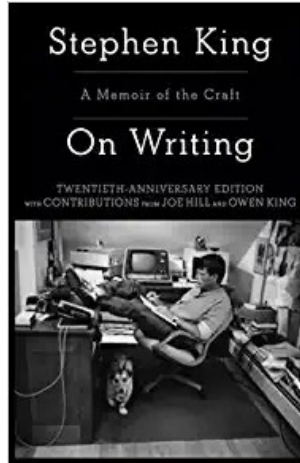


## ACAD/DE ENGLISH 121

Students should prepare a brief 1-2 page typed essay response. Be sure to format your paper according to [MLA guidelines](#)[Links to an external site.](#) and edit your work using Grammarly before submitting the polished draft to Canvas.

**Due Date:** Whether you are taking this course in term one or term two, you should submit your essay response no later than **Tuesday, September 3 by 11:59 pm.**
